Project Description:

The Lynwood Regional Justice Facility (currently known as the Century Regional Detention Facility – CRDF) is a 1,000-bed California Type I/II local adult detention facility. The LRJC also incorporates a Sheriff's patrol station with all necessary computer-aided radio dispatch systems and arraignment courts. The construction cost of this facility was \$117 million. The facility is now 100% operational.

ACSI's Responsibilities:

ACSI was engaged by the County of Los Angeles to provide planning and QC/QA services for the security, controls, life safety and communications portion of this project.

PLANNING: During the planning phase of this project, ACSI met with the Sheriff's Department for the purpose of understanding how this new custody facility would be operated once complete. Once the planned administrative requirements were documented, ACSI prepared a security plan for the entire facility. Communication systems requirements were then documented and ACSI then developed the Design Intent Document (DID) for the Center.

DESIGN: During the design phase of the project, ACSI monitored the A/E team's designs for conformance with the DID. Where anomalies or significant deviations were noted, ACSI prepared Corrective Action Reports (CARs) and met with the A/E team to discuss the content of ACSI's CARs.

CONSTRUCTION: Throughout the construction phase, ACSI monitored the contractor's submittals, shop drawings and work in-place preparing CARs as necessary. As the project neared completion, ACSI developed a test plan, monitored the effectiveness of the contractor's quality control activities and independently tested the performance of all electronic systems.
